Four Months to Go to the Delano Kindred Annual Meeting in Delano, Minnesota!

The dates of the next Delano Kindred Annual Meeting and Reunion are now fast approaching. Please put the dates of September 16, 17, and 18 on your calendar and plan to join us either in person in Delano or on Zoom. Registration for the annual meeting and hotel information is now open and you may do so by going to the Delano Kindred website (www.delanokindred.us) and clicking on the "Reunion" menu at the top of the page. As you can see in the photos (above) of the banners found on the main streets of the town of Delano, it has an openness and a community spirit which are very refreshing, and not found in many communities.

In the coming newsletters, we will go into more detail about the town of Delano and its namesake, Francis Roach "FR" Delano. Briefly, however, Delano was founded as a stop on St. Paul and Pacific Railroad which reached there in 1868 from Minneapolis and St. Paul. From Delano, the railroad continued westward up to Moorhead/Fargo and then eventually to Seattle. The building of the St. P&P RR and its importance in opening western Minnesota and the US Northwest will be the theme of the presentations at this meeting.

As for the meeting program, we begin the meeting on Friday afternoon, Sept. 16 at 1 pm with a welcome from the Mayor of Delano, Dale Graunke, followed by Tom Delano speaking on FR Delano, his great, great grandfather. After a break, Duane Swanson, the former curator of the railroad archive of the Minnesota Historical Society will speak on the importance of St. P&P RR in Minnesota history. Then we will go on a walking tour of downtown Delano and finish at the nearby Historic Rieder Barn for a reception. On Saturday, Sept. 17, we will hold the annual meeting at 10 am followed by a talk on the history of Delano by Jon Steinmetz, president of the Delano Historical Society. We will then take our group photo in front of the railroad motif at the Delano Public Library. The afternoon is open and attendees may either visit the Delano Heritage Center or take a short walk to Delano Central Park and participate in the Delano

Oktoberfest...or do both. Prost! The evening activities will begin at 6 pm with a reception followed by dinner at 6:45 pm. This promises to be an educational and fun meeting so please read the upcoming newsletters for more meeting information and we hope to see you in Delano!

President's Note from Tom Delano

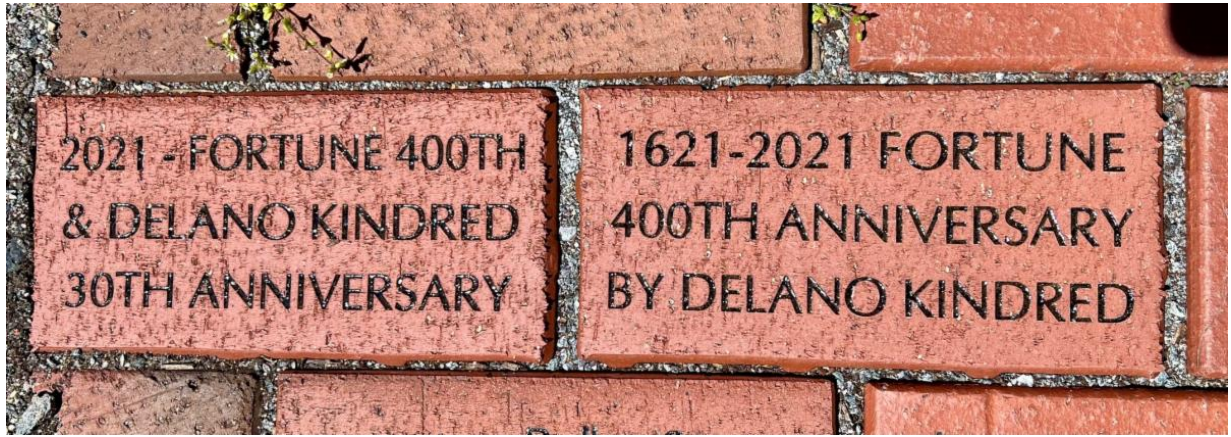
The Delano Kindred Contributes \$14,300 to the Alden Building Campaign.
